**1. CATEGORY OF POST**

**EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION.**

**Village Revenue Officer**

Must have passed **Intermediate** Examination conducted by the Andhra Pradesh State Board of Intermediate Examination or its equivalent Examination.

The applicant shall be the native of the District for which the Recruitment is notified.

**2. AGE:-**

The Selection of candidates is based on a objective type Written Test for 100 Marks at Intermediate level.

\* 50% of questions (30 Marks) will be aimed at testing the knowledge of the candidate on rural areas and rural living conditions.
